

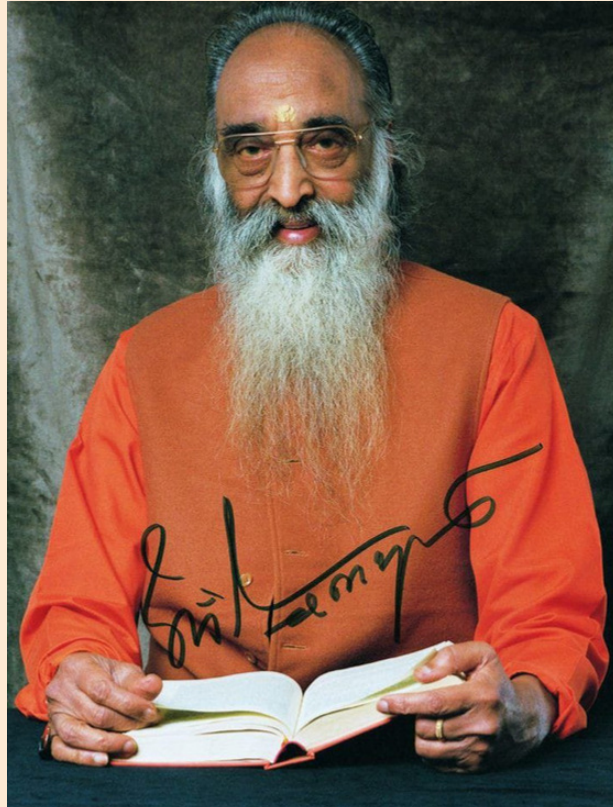

Students of class 9 accompanied by teachers visited FCI to gain knowledge of food grain storage, preservation and liquidation.
