



First Aid Trainig

The proflgramme was organized in association with Daya Hospital, Thrissur. The class was handled by Sri. Basheer, **Retd. The students could acquire in depth information regarding the emergency first aid to be given during cardiac arrest, stroke, choking, fainting etc. After the session, the demonstration using dummy and live demonstration was also held up which enabled the students to understand the procedure better. At the end of the session, students were allowed to demonstrate the knowledge gained by using the dummy to show how CPR is done.








Sapthati celebration of H.H Viviktananda Saraswathi
