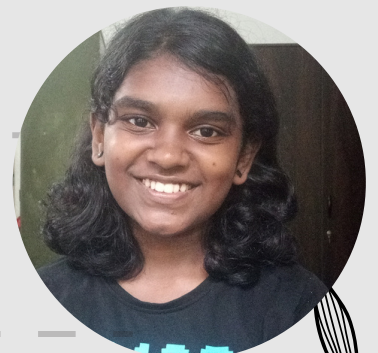

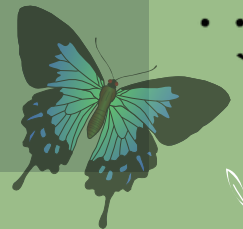

# Cluster X Football Tournament



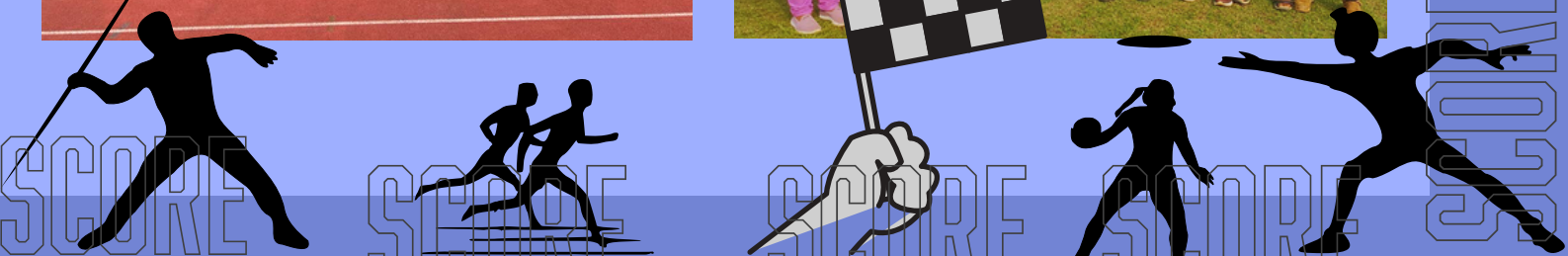
